- ◆ We've received a \$10,000 grant from Linn County Solid Waste Agency.

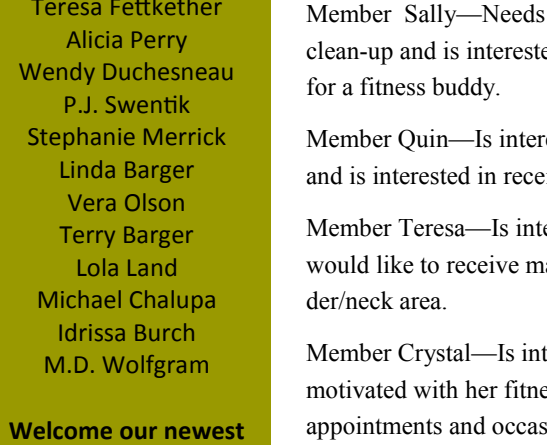

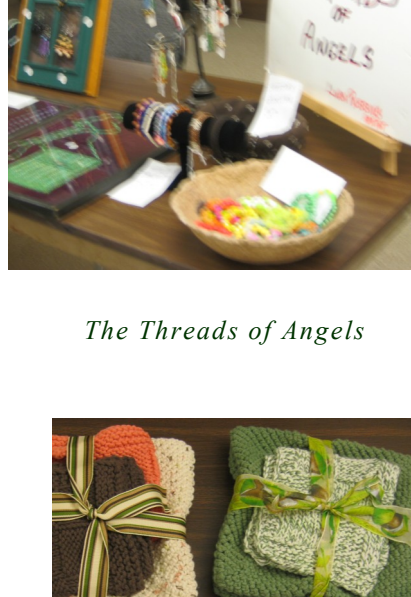

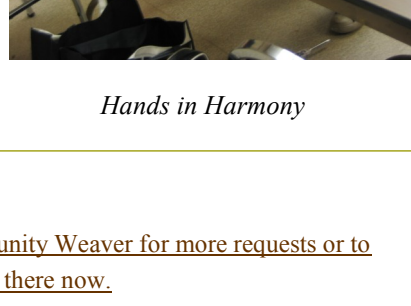
