A Simple Way to Earn A Free Time Dollar

Time banking works when all members participate. We've noticed that only a handful of current members have logged in to their Community Weaver accounts and we want this to change. We are challenging ALL of our members log in to Community Weaver from now until August 31st and earn one (1) time dollar*.

It's that simple to sign in:

1. Go to: <http://tapestry.timebanks.org>
2. The Sign In is located on the right side of the page.
3. Enter your full email address and password. Click Log In.
4. If you have forgotten your password click "Request new password" and an email will be sent to you with instructions.

Once you are logged in look around the site. View available offers and requests and consider posting some of your own. All members should have two (2) time dollars in their accounts for the orientation and interview. If you notice you are missing these dollars please contact [The Tapestry](#) so we can correct it.

*One time dollar per account. Time dollars will be posted to eligible accounts on Wednesdays.

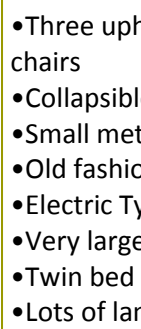
Upcoming Events

10 time dollars for a large appliance, sofa, dining suite and bedroom set

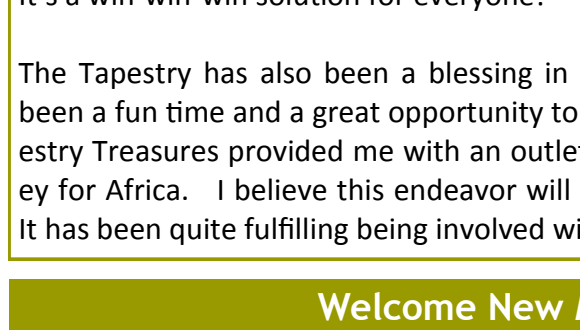
5 time dollars for a small appliance, chair, occasional table, electronic equipment and objects d'art

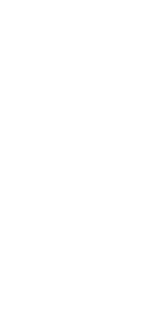
