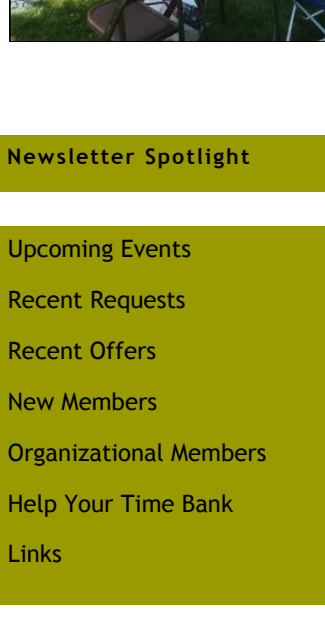
Tapestry Update!

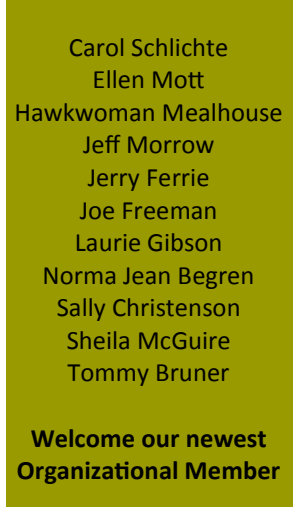

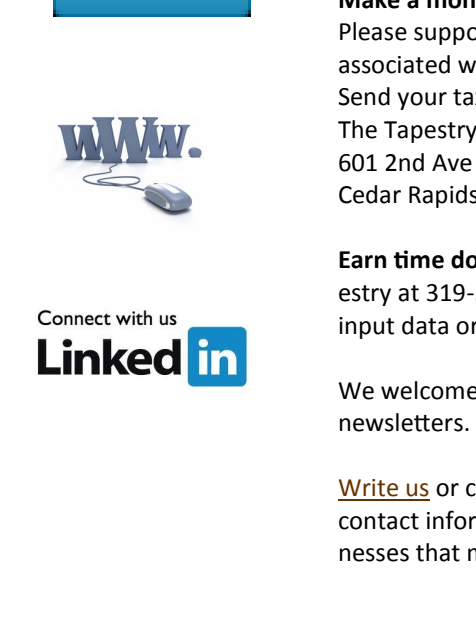

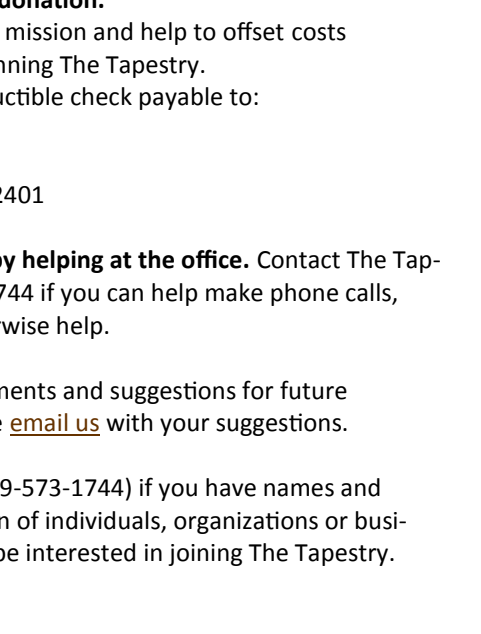
