## Welcome to hOurworld Time and Talents!

As of today, The Tapestry has officially joined hOurworld. hOurworld connects over 100 Time Banks from across the nation and over 20 Time Banks internationally. This network allows members from Iowa to Time Bank with members from New York, California, Mexico, and the United Kingdom.

hOurworld also hosts a mobile app for both Android and Apple. As part of this partnership, The Tapestry members will begin using Time and Talents software to post their needs and gifts and record their Time Dollars. Time and Talents is very similar to the Community Weaver software The Tapestry has used in the past. The new database will look different than Community Weaver but has all the same functions for posting opportunities and recording your hours. You can still access the database through The Tapestry website just as you did with Community Weaver.

Simply follow the directions below to activate your account with our new system. If the idea of this overwhelms you do not fret! Just contact The Tapestry Volunteer Coordinator, Chelsea, and she will help you get connected.
